2. Have your child sit next to you or on your lap if small.
3. Place all cell phones on vibrate. (Please exit the room to answer phone calls to avoid class disruption.)
4. If your child begins to cry and does not stop within two minutes, please take him/her outside to “discharge” so that class focus can be maintained. If your instructor says, “Maybe s/he needs some water,” please take your child outside until calm returns.
5. Avoid holding private conversations with other parents or your own child once the lesson instruction has begun. By lovingly redirecting your child as needed you will maximize his/her learning.
6. Please be attentive of your child during the art activity and ensure your child does not put objects in his/her mouth that may be swallowed.
7. Have fun and verbalize with your child! Your modeling will promote confidence in the second language.
8. Play your CD at home as often as possible to reinforce learning.
9. Make up lessons are guaranteed only if the teacher misses a lesson. Classes missed by students will not be refunded.
